This past Sunday we had two get baptised. Praise the Lord. We have two others that need to get baptised, but they are struggling with the idea. They are both teenagers and scared. Please pray with us that these two will overcome their fear and follow the Lord in Believers baptism.

After making numerous trips to Palmerston North, we have been able to find a home to rent and hopefully a place to meet for church services. We sign the papers this month and hope to be moved in by the last week of September.

It is our desire to hold our first service on the 10th of October. Please pray that we will be able to get everything resolved by then. We thought that all was well as we had drawn up an agreement with the principal of the school, which is where the hall is that we will be meeting in. The city council advised us that we would need to get a residential consent. This is something new; the principal, as well as other missionaries here, have never been required to get this consent. The application is a minimum of \$500 dollars and then there is no gaurantee that it will be approved. We are wanting to start advertising in a local weekly newspaper, but are concerned that it may be premature depending on the city council's decision. Please pray that it will will be approved.

We just had a bowling activity for our Junior Church age kids and it went very well as we had a total of twenty-six that were present. The next activity we are planning is an all-niter on the 23rd of September for our teens. We are really excited; many of the teens are bringing friends, which we have been praying for. Pray for souls to be saved. We celebrated New Zealand's Father Day this past Sunday and the teens sang a special to the Dads, as seen in the picture to the left.
