The program ran Monday through Friday from 9:00 am until 12:00 noon. Our attendance increased daily (26, 38, 45, 47, & 65). We had over eighty different children attend. Though we are exhausted, we are already praying and planning for next year's program. We are praying that we will have enough workers needed to do the program next year. We had a marriage seminar Tuesday through Thursday evening the same week that the Holiday Bible Program was running. For the past seven months our church has been praying for one of the couples that attended. They were present every night, and decided to start some counseling in hopes of repairing their marriage. While the mission team was here from America, we did door-to-door visitation and handed out brochures and fliers almost every day. Through this effort, we were able to get several to come to the HBP and the marriage seminar. In addition, heaps (a whole lot) of people heard the Gospel. I had one gentleman say he wanted to receive Christ as his Savior until he heard that he must repent of his sin and begin living as God's Word says. In the end, he said that he would have to think about it. Many are happy to add Jesus onto their lives, but to repent and change their lives is something completely different. Pray that Mark will make a decision to receive Christ.
