We have one who has come forward for baptism and another who needs to get baptized, so we have scheduled a baptismal service for the first week in March. There is one other who has been saved and needs to get baptized, but is terrified of water, so pray for her (Zelda).

Some of you may or may not have heard we are coming home on a short six-month furlough. We hope to be in America the first part of October 2006 and return to New Zealand in March of 2007.
