As we reported last time, we have several men from the Philippines that have received their Resident Visas and were able to bring their families over to New Zealand. We also had a man from Papua New Guinea, who came to Palmerston North for higher education, who also joined the church. He hopes to get his wife and children to New Zealand at the beginning of next year.

In August, Cody held a Gospel Sunday service and had 7 visitors attend. Many of them have continued to come back. He also put out a sign-up sheet for discipleship classes and four people signed up. Cody is already discipling four and his wife is discipling two. Praise the Lord for people that want to grow in their walk with the Lord. Many of our people are inviting friends to come to church and they have seen the attendance grow. We are excited to see what God is doing in New Zealand.
